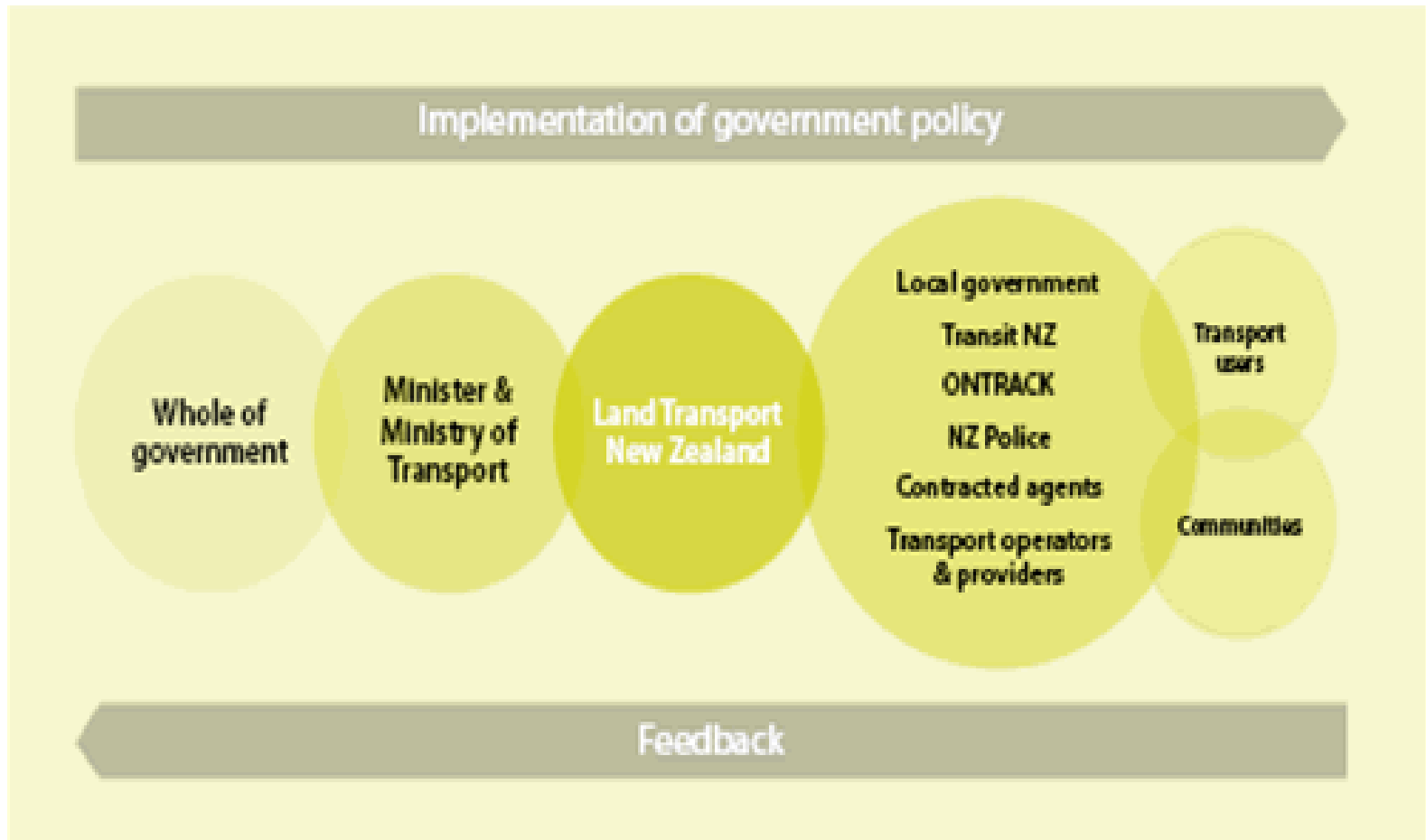

Land Transport NZ/ New Zealand Transport Agency	Funding, regulatory role, assist and advise, state highways*

- **Three Phases of Improvements**
 - **Purpose statement**
 - **The Total Mobility Scheme is to assist eligible people with impairments to access appropriate transport to enhance their community participation..."**
 - **Consistent eligibility criteria**
